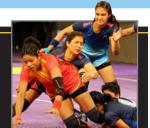

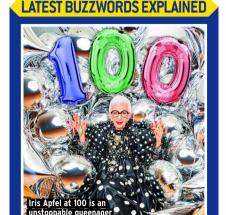

ood storage is really an ancient art. Cave dwellers buried their hunted game in snow. Storing food was a survival skill and the inspiration behind all sorts of delicious traditional foods that we still enjoy today. Yet frozen food suffers from a bad rap today, thanks to the whole fixation with everything local and organic. Fresh intuitively looks more edible. But as technologies develop, we will increasingly have to choose between fresh, frozen, vacuumed and many other options. Buying frozen foods can help you, your supermarket, and the whole supply chain waste less.

"In an ideal world, most of the produce we consume, they would all processed locally, unadulterated, fresh and sustainably grown. The truth however is far from that. With shortfresh food,

we have become

dependent on packaging

and processing food," says nutri-

tionist Manjari Chandra. A simple way of processing food is to freeze it at the produce and consume it when desired.

Wasting less food is about keeping ingredients fresh, being creative with what you have, and getting to know your food, especially how it ages and how it is best stored. And despite its bad rap, frozen food—and freezing food - is one of the keys to turning around the food-waste trend. In most cases blanching is absolutely essential for producing quality frozen vegetables. Blanching also helps to destroy microorganisms on the surface of the vegetable and to make some vegetables, such as broccoli and spinach, more compact. "Frozen products should not be stored for long periods in "frost-free" home freezers, because these go through warming cycles to defrost coils and inherently warm products stored in them," adds Chandra.

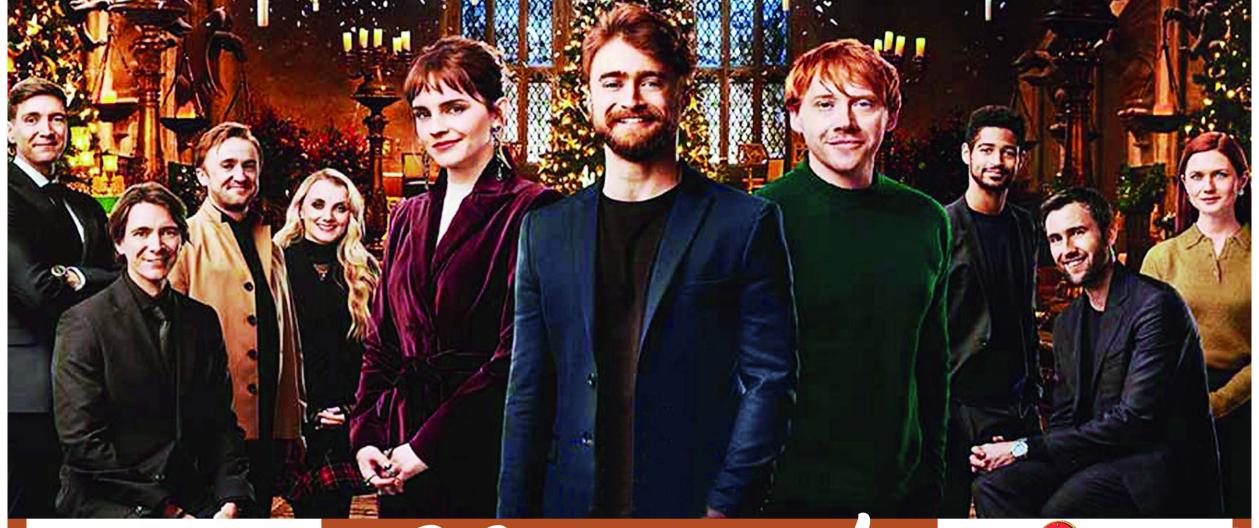

HARRY POTTER AND THE **PRISONER OF AZKABAN**

DIRECTOR: ALFONSO

'Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban' was directed by Mexican director Alfonso Cuarón, known for his stunning visual storytelling. The cast of previous instalments returned for the film, with the additions of Gary Oldman, David Thewlis, and Emma Thompson,

among others. It was the first appearance of Michael Gambon as Professor Albus Dumbledore, due to Richard Harris' death in 2002 (Harris played Dumbledore in the first two films). It was the first in the series to extensively use real-life locations, with sets built in Scotland and scenes shot

Filming concluded in November 2003 and it was released on 31 May 2004 in the UK, and on 4 June 2004 in North America, as the first Harry Potter film using IMAX technology and released into IMAX theatres. "... Prisoner of Azkaban' grossed a total of over \$797 million worldwide, making it the second-highestgrossing film of 2004, and received praise for Cuarón's direction and the lead actors' performances. The film is credited for marking a notable change in the franchise's tone and directorial style, and is often considered by critics and fans alike to be the best Harry Potter film. It was nominated for two Academy Awards, Best Original Music Score and Best Visual Effects at the 77th Academy Awards in 2004.



HARRY POTTER OF FIRE

2005 **DIRECTOR: MIKE NEWELL IMDB RATING: 7.7**

Directed by British director Mike Newell, the fourth film of the series was the first to receive a PG-13 certificate in the US, and a 12A in the UK. Filming began in early 2004. The Hogwarts scenes were shot at the Leavesden Film Studios. Five days after its

release, the film had grossed over US\$102 million at the North American box office, which is the third-highest first-weekend tally for a Harry Potter film, right after 'Harry Potter and the Deathly Hallows Part 1 and Part 2' (in terms of BO earnings). '... Goblet of Fire' enjoyed an immensely successful run at the box office, earning \$896 million worldwide, which made it the highest-grossing film of 2005 and the sixth-highest-grossing film in the Harry Potter series.

The film was nominated for the Academy Award for Best Art Direction, and won the BAFTA Award for Best Production Design. '...Goblet of Fire' was the second film in the series to be released in IMAX. The film is one of the best-reviewed instalments within the series, being praised for the higher level of maturity and sophistication of its characters, plotline. tone, screenplay, and the performances of the lead actors.

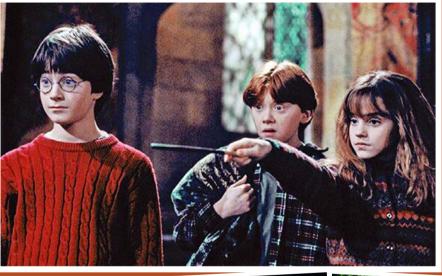

IMDB RATING: 7.6 With an estimated budget of \$250 million, '... The Half Blood Prince' is one of the most expensive films ever made and the most expensive film in the Harry Potter film series. The film was simultaneously released in regular cinemas and IMAX 3D. The film released theatri cally worldwide on 15 July

and was a major commercial success, breaking the record for the biggest single-day worldwide gross. In five days the film made \$394 million, breaking the record for highest fiveday worldwide gross. With a total gross of \$934 million, it became the eighth-highest-grossing film of all time, and 2009's second-highest-grossing film (behind 'Avatar'). It is the fifth-highest-grossing film in the franchise.

The film also received positive reviews, with praise for Yates's direction, the performances, Delbonnel's cinematography, Nicholas Hooper's musical score, and "emotionally satisfying" story. It was nominated at the 82nd Academy Awards for Best Cinematography and the 63rd British Academy Film Awards for Best Special Visual Effects and Best Production Design.
