he Union environment ministry has designated October 5 as the National Dolphin Day, to be celebrated annually starting this year. The decision to designate a National Dolphin Day was taken by the standing committee of the National Board for Wildlife (NBWL) on Friday, according to a statement by the environment ministry. The idea behind recommending October 5 as 'National Dolphin Day' is to generate awareness and encourage community participation for the conservation of this species wherever t's found in the country.

Dolphins act as ideal ecological indicators of a healthy aquatic ecosystem. Its conservation will, therefore, help survival of the species and also benefit the people dependent on the aquatic system for their livelihood. River Dolphins are found in Ganga-Brahmaputra-Meghna-Indus river systems

The environment ministry had in May, 2010, notified the Gangetic Dolphin as the 'National Aquatic Animal' of India



YOGA - VRIKSHASANA


has been taken from the Sanskrit word 'vrksha' meaning tree and asana meaning 'posture'. Vrikshasana or tree pose is a

PROCEDURE:

Stand erect with arms by the side of your body. Bend your right knee and place the right foot on your left thigh. The role of the foot should be kept flat near the foot of the thigh. Your left leg should be straight, the right leg should be head down. Inhale and try to make namaskar mudra with your palms. Maintain proper balance. Try to make your spine straight with deep inhale, bring your arms and leas down.

Repeat the same with your left leg. This completes one round. Perform three-five



anada qualified for the World Cup for the first time in 36 years on Sunday with an emphatic 4-0 victory over Jamaica in Toronto. Goals from Cyle Larin, Tajon Buchanan, Junior Hoilett and an Adrian Mariappa own goal secured all three points after Canada dominated against a Jamaica side already eliminated from contention in the CONCACAF region's qualifying tournament for this year's finals in Qatar.

WILD CELEBRATIONS

The win sparked wild celebrations at Toronto's 30,000-capacity BMO Field, where an expectant sell-out crowd had gathered to watch Canada clinch World Cup qualification for only the second time, having last appeared at the 1986 Mexico

Canada's English manager John Herdman _ who took over the men's team in 2018 after a successful stint in charge of Canada's women's team _said the qualification was proof that Canada was a 'football country"

After a dominant qualifying campaign had left them three points clear with two games remaining, Canada needed only a point from Sunday's fixture to assure themselves of qualification. That objective was never in doubt as Canada went on the attack from the whistle

Larin could have opened the scoring after only five minutes, but his shot was well saved by Jamaican goalkeeper Andre Blake. But Larin made no mistake in the 13th minute to bag Canada's opener. A lovely team move ended with

PULISIC HAT TRICK MOVES US CLOSER TO WORLD CUP

hristian Pulisic scored his first international hat trick, leading the United States to the brink of returning to the World Cup with a 5-1 rout of Panama.

Pulisic converted two penalty kicks during a four-goal burst in the first half that also saw Paul Arriola and Jesús Ferreira score, then boosted the lead to 5-0 on memorable goal with two brilliant touches that evaded a pair of defenders on Sunday. With fans still fretting after the


